

# 16. Left and Right

**Subject:** Left and Right

**Book 2,** p. 18

**CD Song** 18, Here We Go Loobe Lo

**Flash cards:** Yes.

**Supplementary material:** No

**Grammar & phrases:** left and right, crossing the road, traffic, traffic lights, zebra crossing

**Recommended material:** a steering wheel for symbolizing a car and a bus

**Suggested length of unit:** 2-3 lessons

Listen to the story about traffic and crossing the road.

Create a street situation with a zebra crossing and a traffic light.

Let the children act out the little story:

Peter points at the toyshop, Jane points at the bus and tells him to be careful (You have to look right and then left and right again before you cross the road.) After having done this, they both cross the road.

Do the Looby Loo song.

## **Activities p. 20-21**

The children are asked to draw teddy's missing body parts (refer to the "Quarrel in the Children's Room").

They should sort out whether the hands and feet are left or right ones by colouring in the circles blue for left and red for right.

It might get a bit complicated because some of the body parts are depicted upside down.

Discuss and practice this with the children.
